**Definition of Consent**

**Consent** is defined as the voluntary, affirmative, and conscious communication of agreement to engage in sexual activity. It is the responsibility of each person to obtain affirmative and voluntary consent before engaging in sexual activity.

A person who is intoxicated by alcohol or drugs is unable to give consent.

A person who is asleep or unconscious is unable to give consent.

A person who is incapable of giving consent due to a mental or physical condition is unable to give consent.
